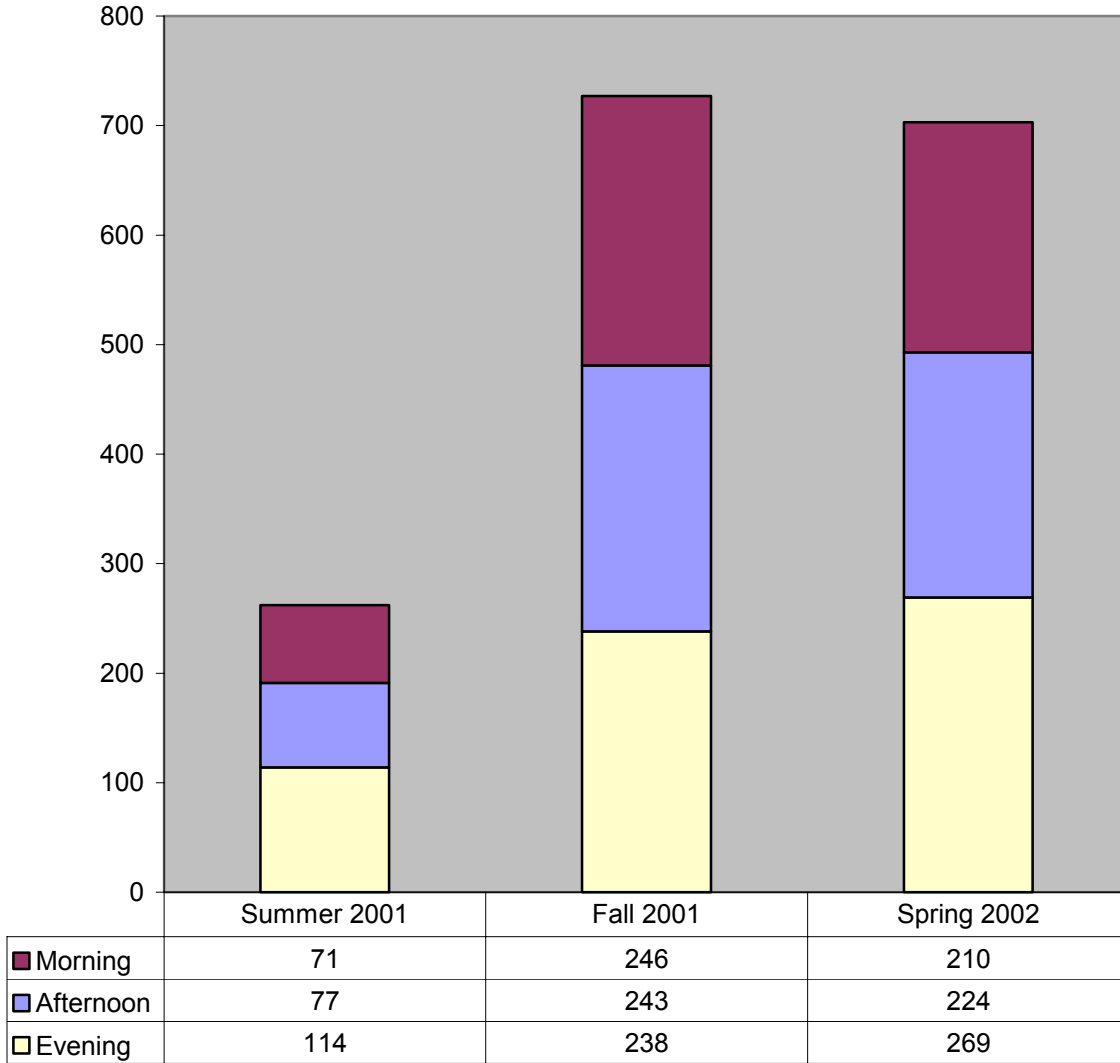

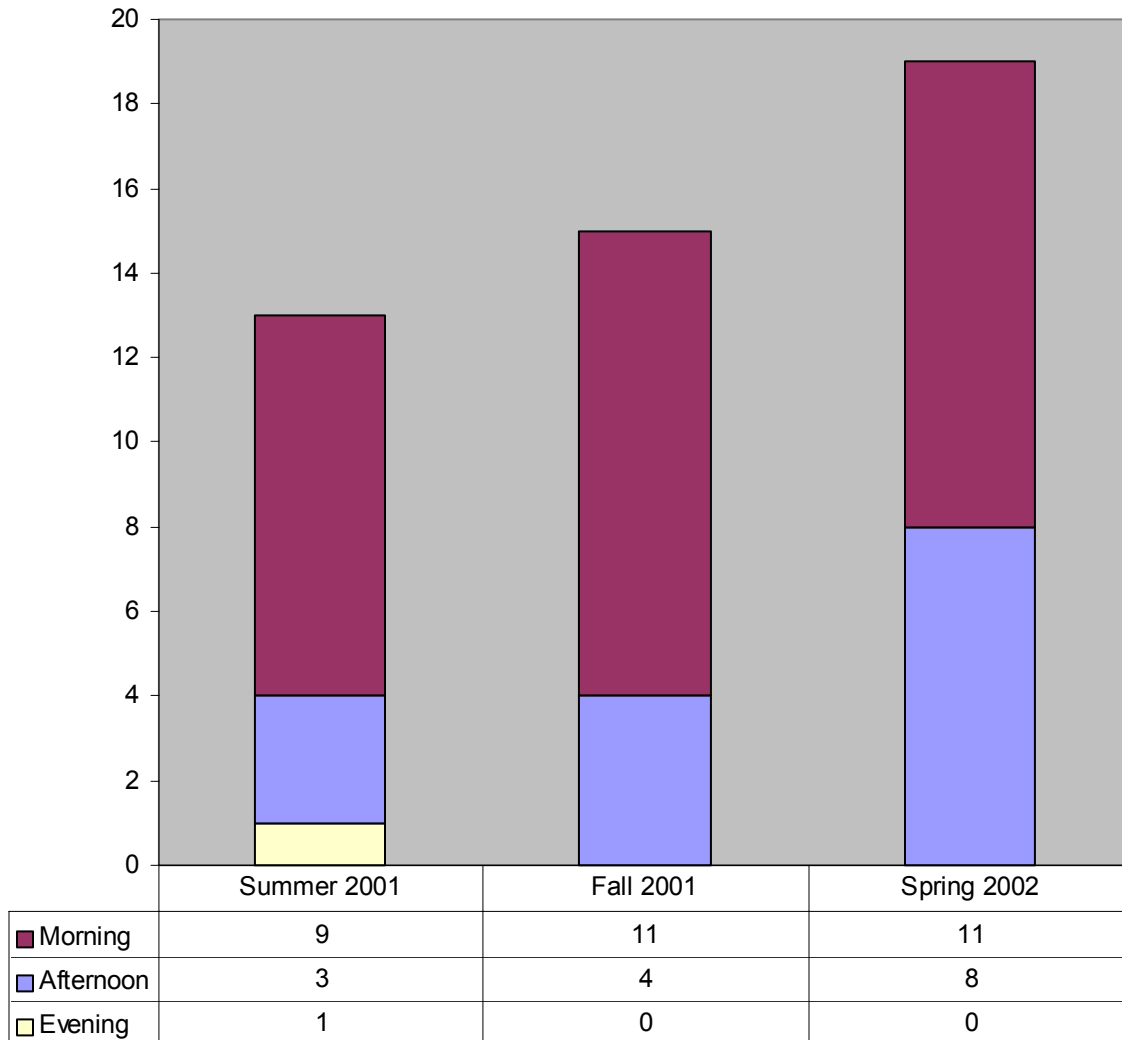

AY 01-02**



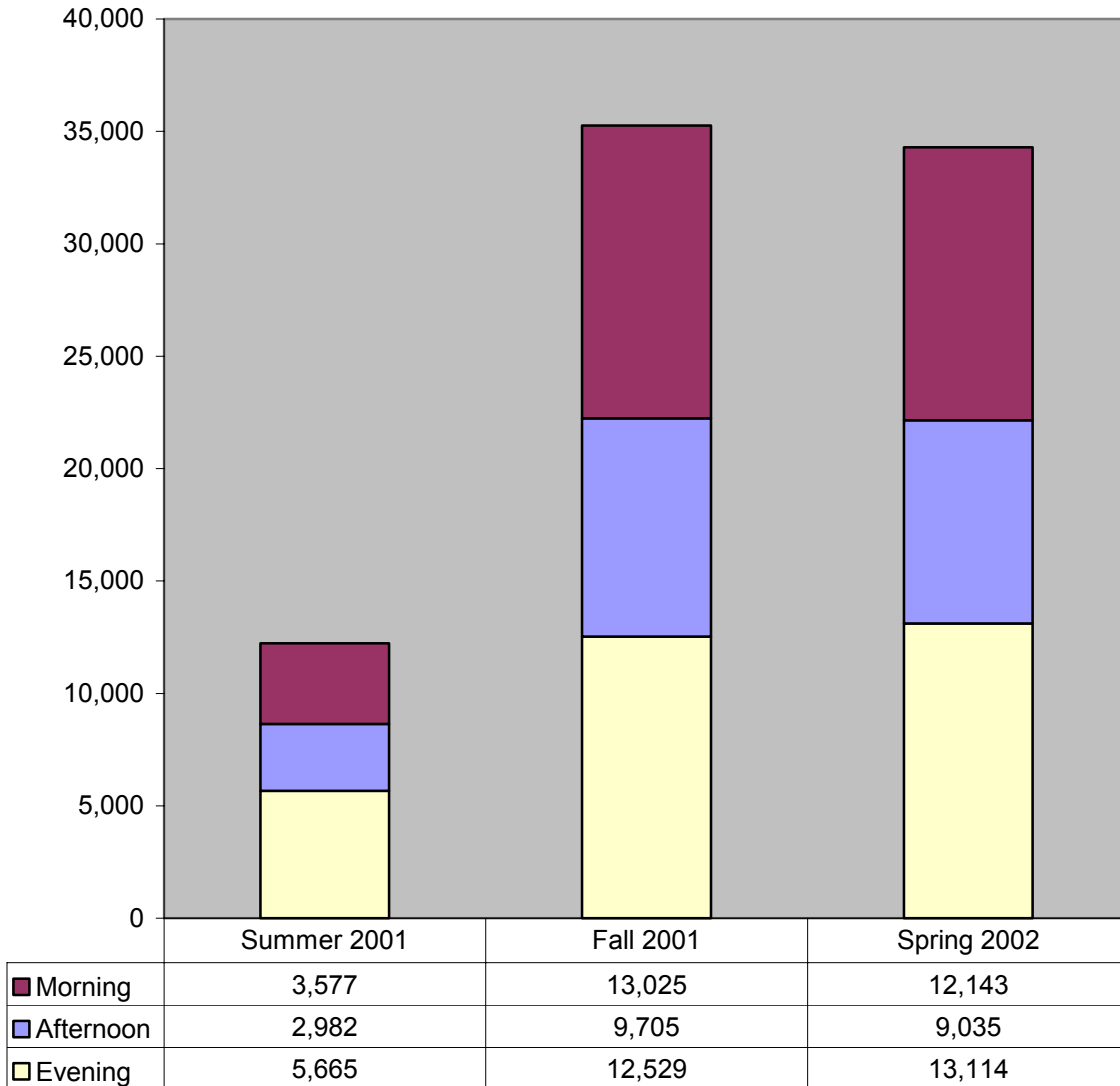
 During all three terms, the greatest number of Monday-Friday classes commenced between 6-7:45pm (21% in summer, 28% in fall and 32% in spring).

AY 01-02**



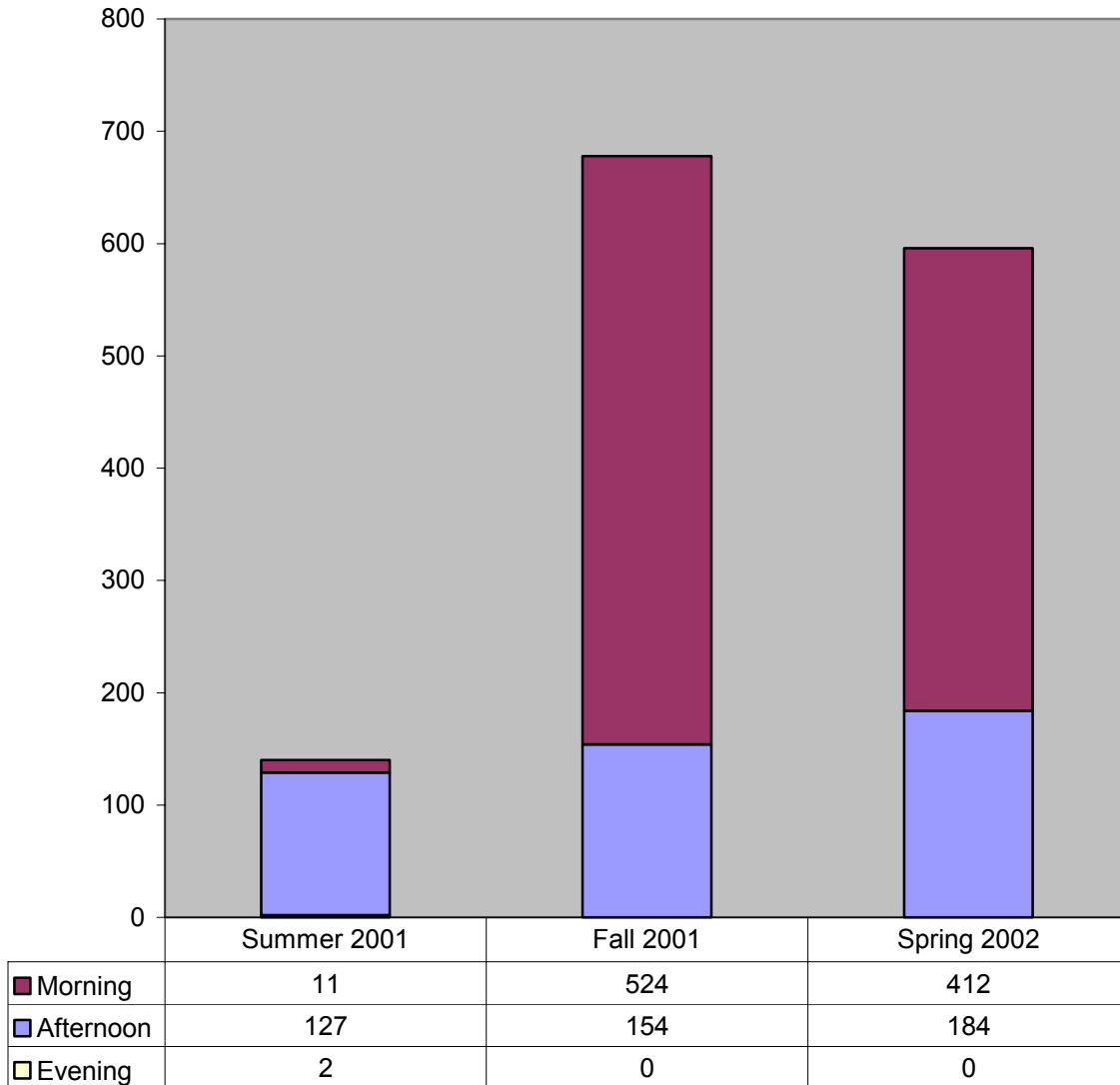
 **54% of Saturday-Sunday classes commenced before 9am in summer, 40% from 9-10:55am in fall, and 47% from 9-10:55am in spring.**

AY 01-02**



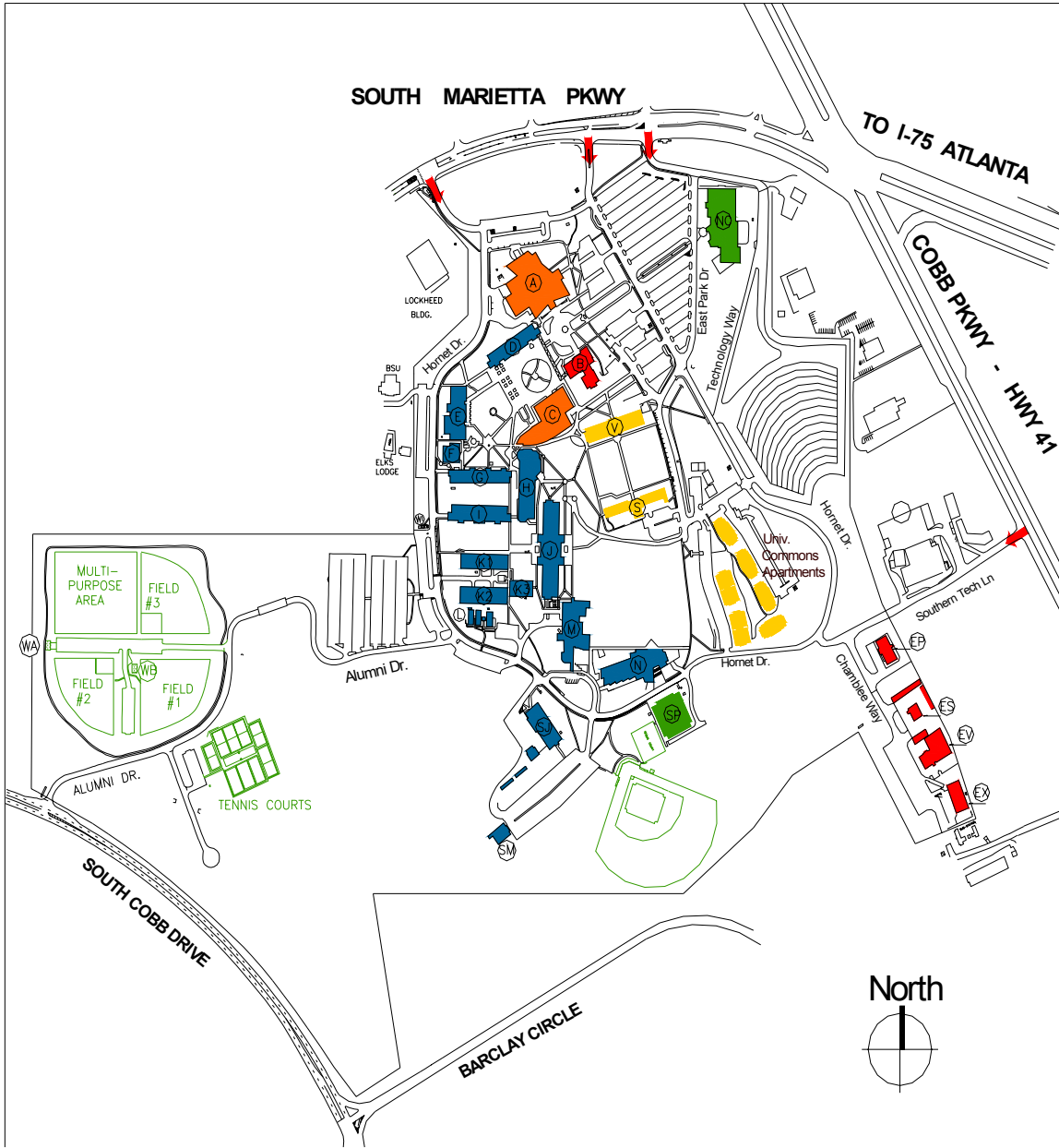
