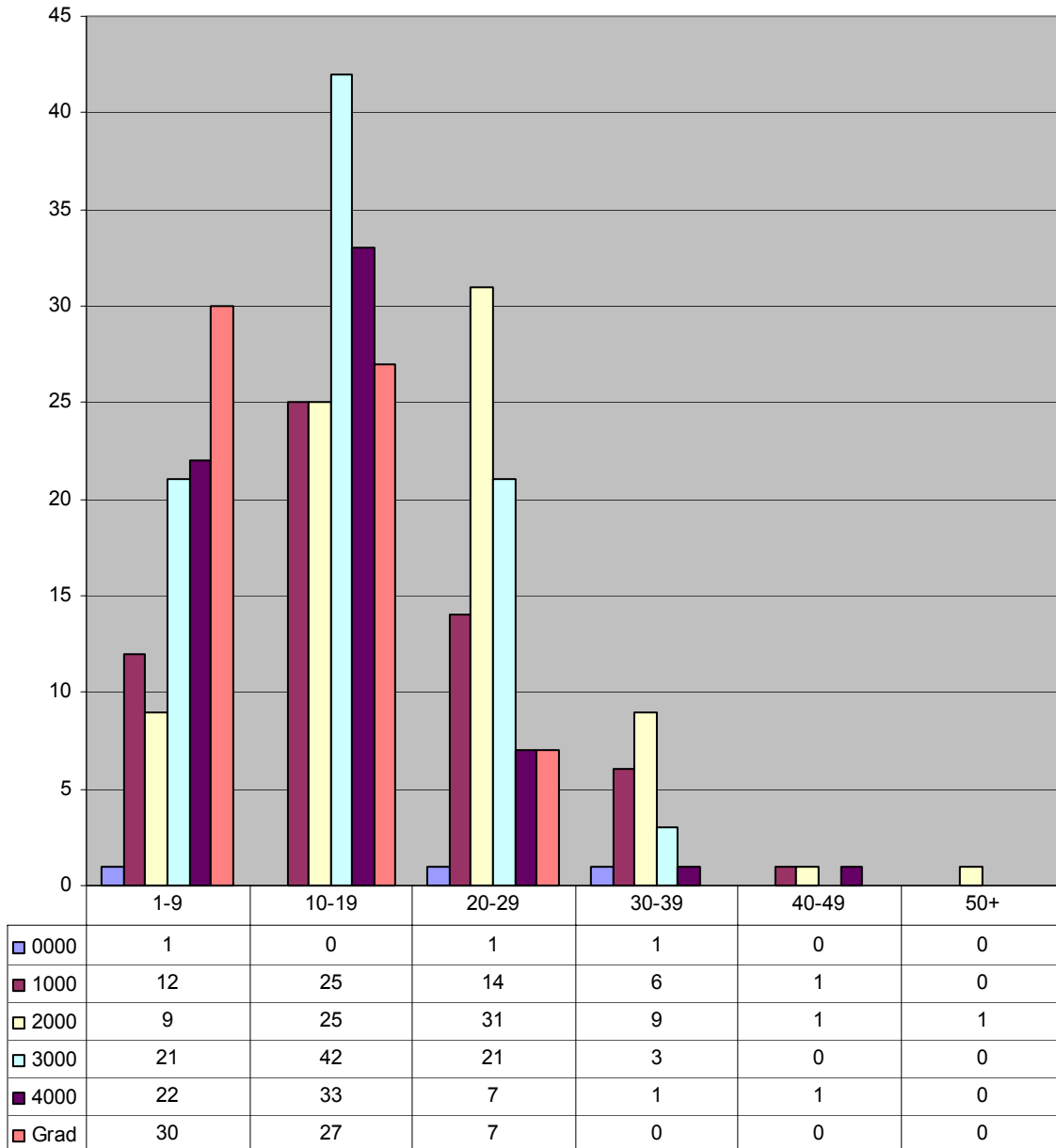

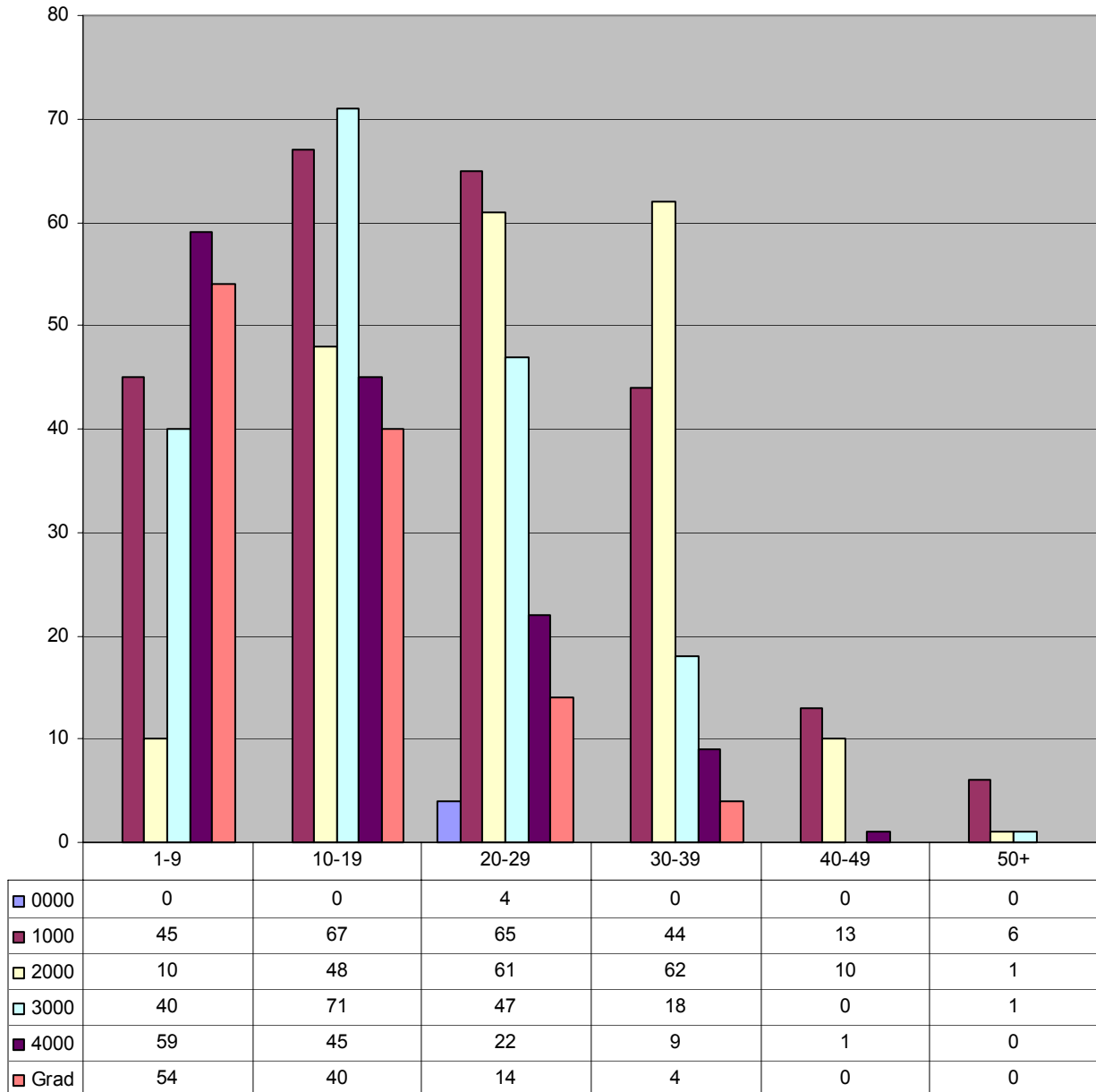
**Class Level by Class Size

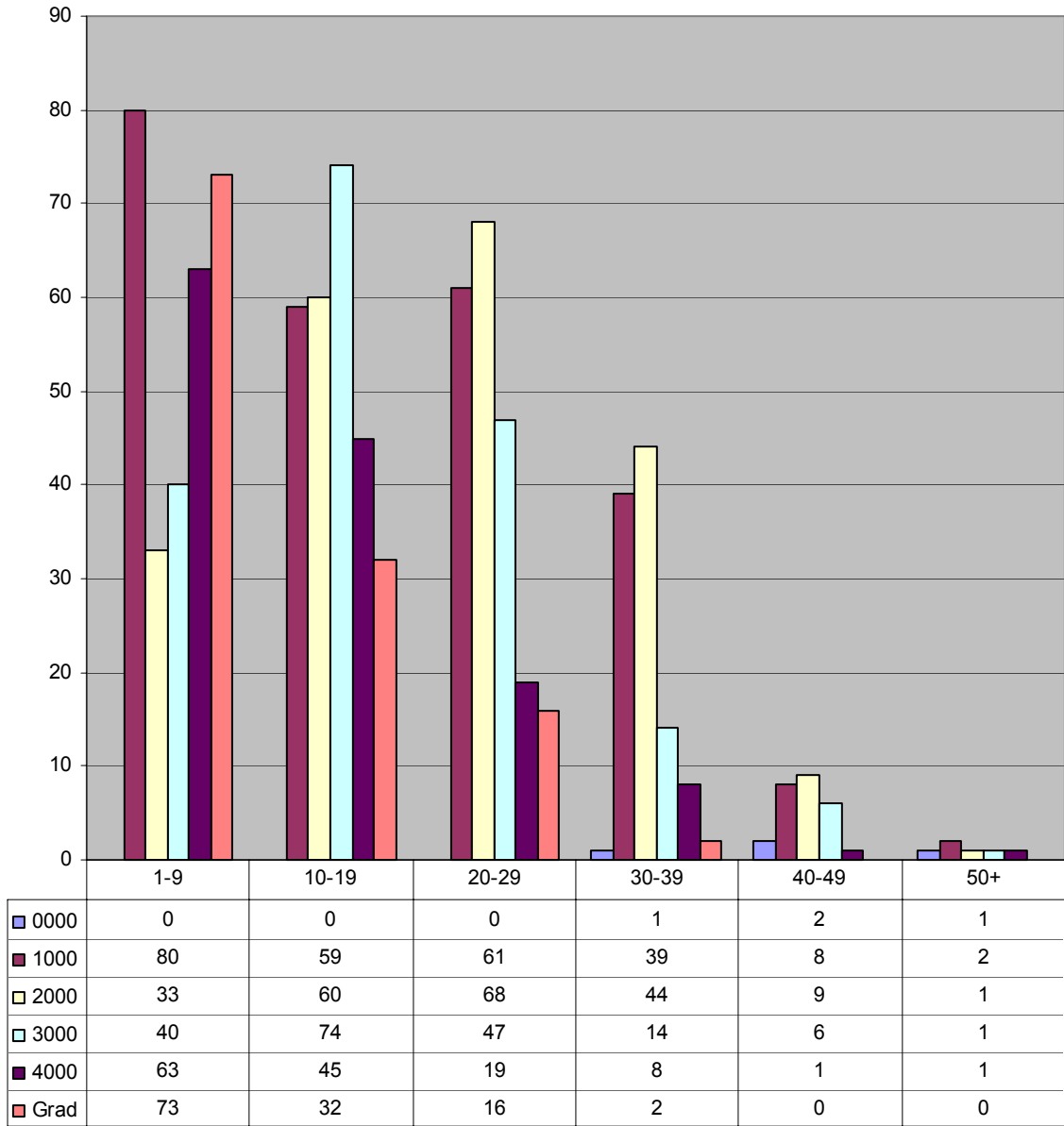
Class Level by Class Size Fall 04

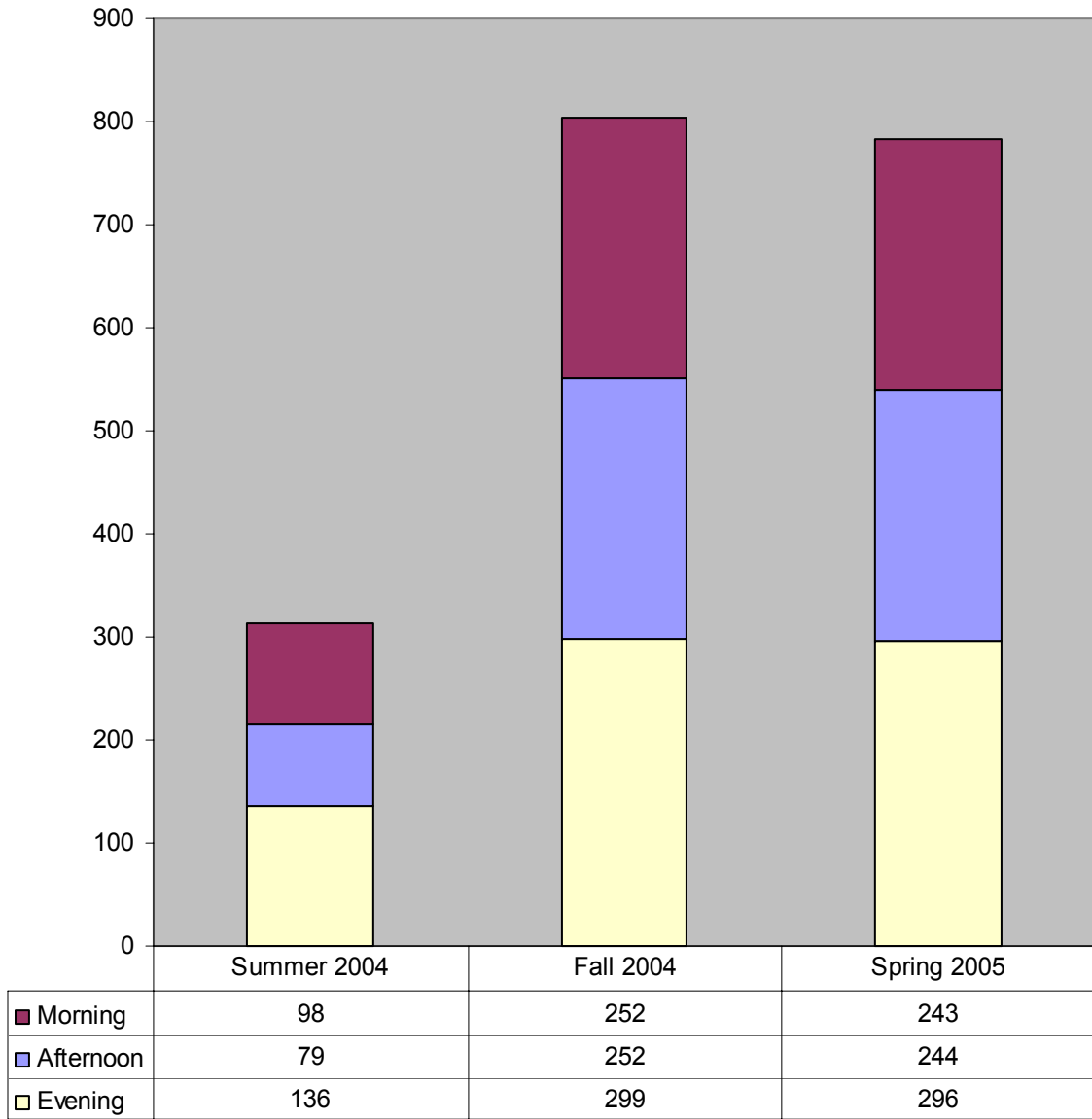
Class Level by Class Size Spring 05

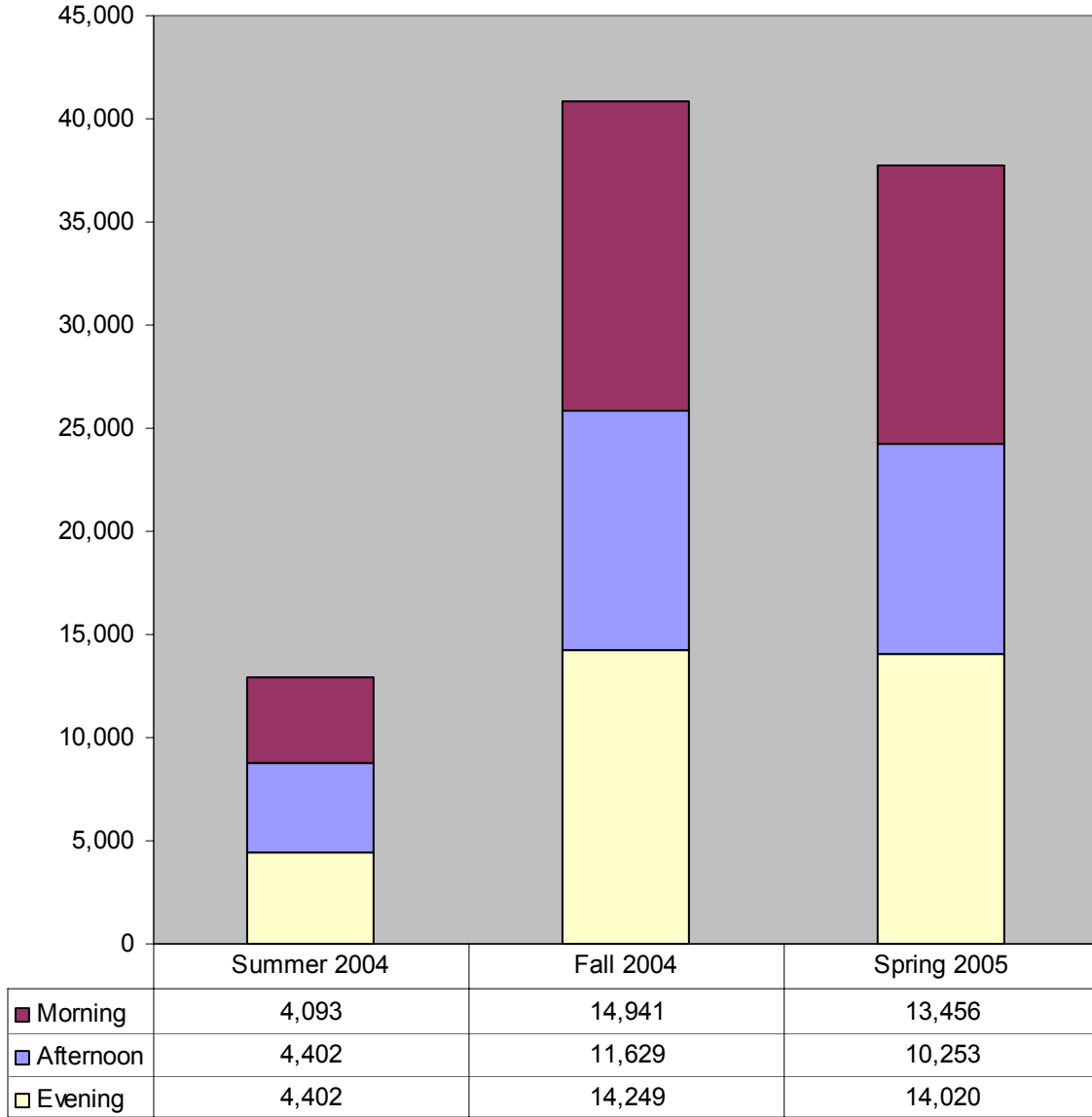
**Class Sections by Class Time

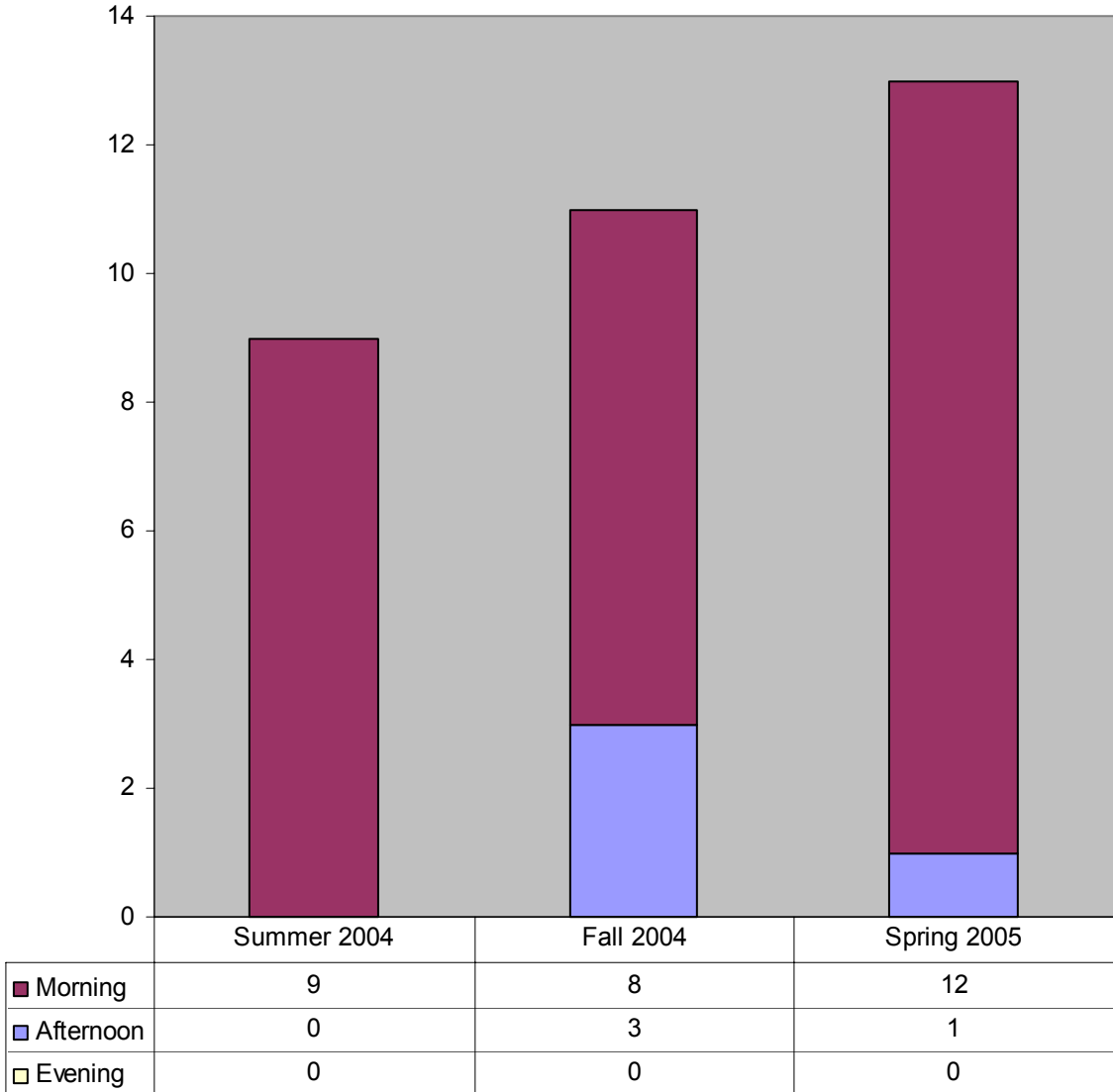
**Student Credit Hours by Class Time

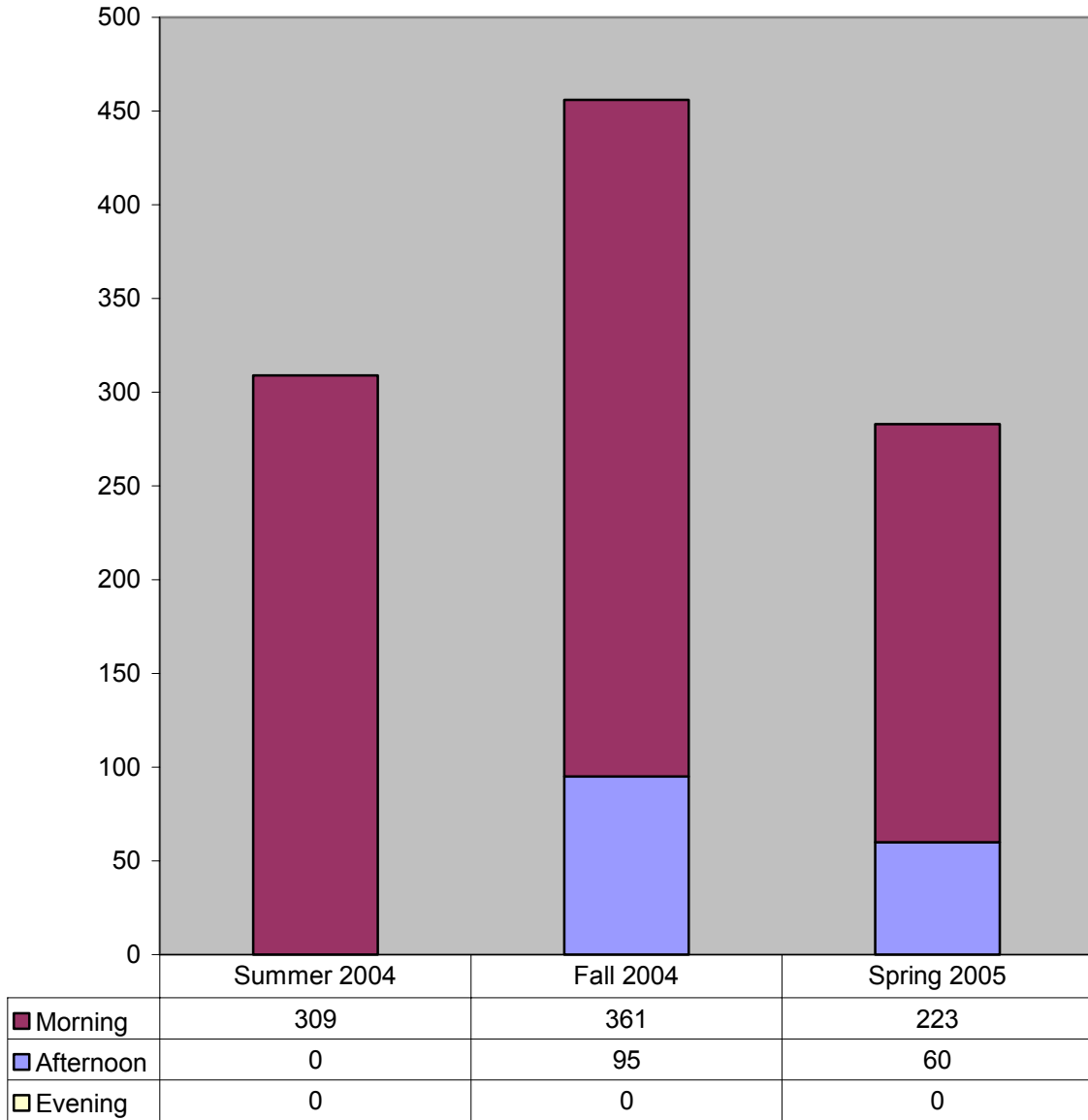
**Class Sections by Class Time

 **During Fall 04, the largest percentage of Saturday/Sunday classes commenced between 9-10:55pm (73%).**

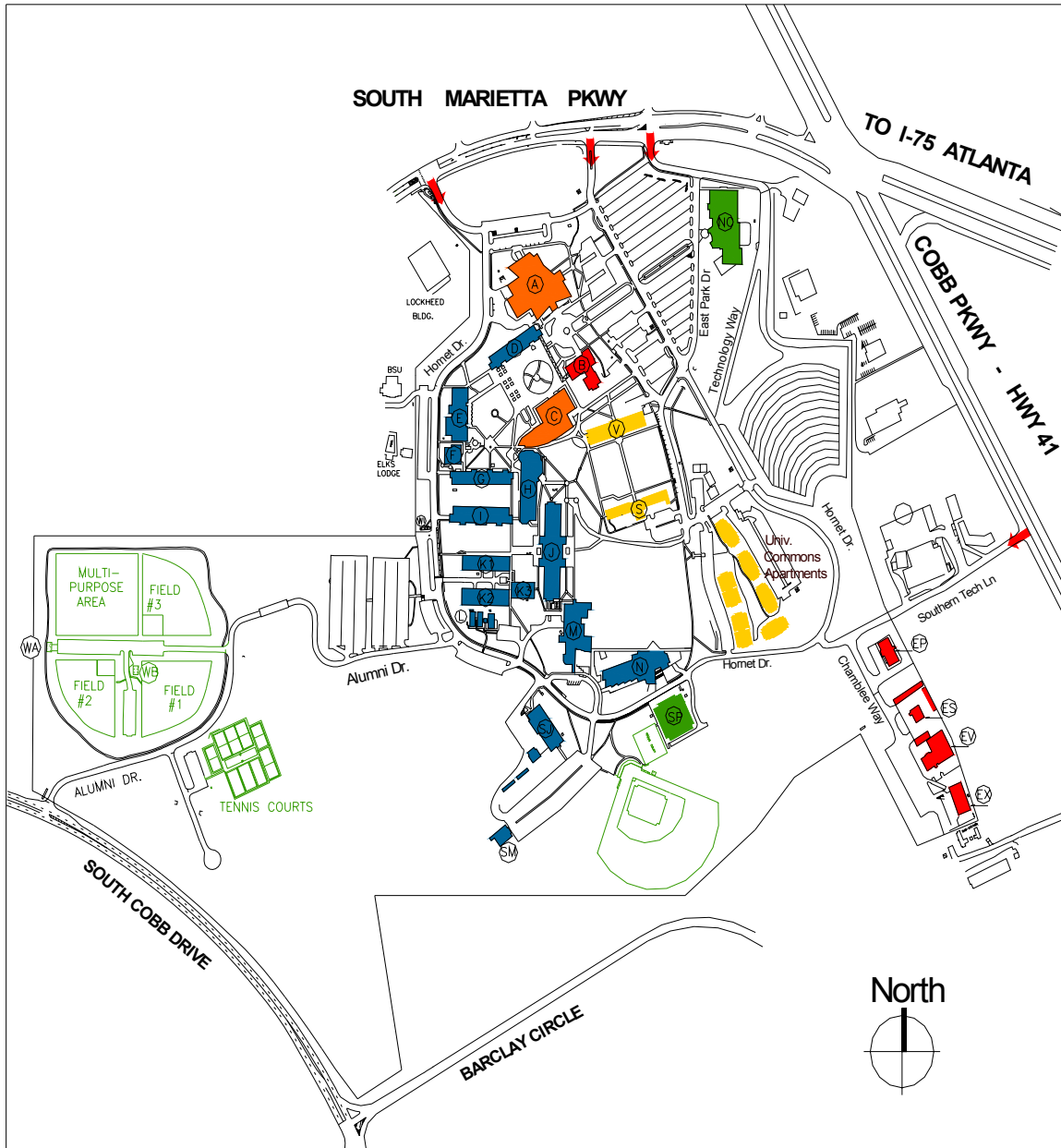
**Student Credit Hours by Class Time
